

THE JOHN FRIEND SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

John Friend became the Athletic Director at Purdue University Calumet in 1980. While he was a daily part of the athletic program at the University, the Fitness Center opened, intercollegiate athletics expanded and intramural opportunities for student health and wellness increased tremendously. Upon his retirement from the University in 2001, the John Friend Scholarship Endowment was established by friends and colleagues to honor his years of commitment to Purdue University Calumet with gifts to the school and programs he so believed in.

AWARD

Multiple scholarships of \$1,000 will be awarded for the academic year covering the fall semester of 2010 and the spring semester of 2011.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be a junior majoring in Hospitality and Tourism Management, Fitness Management option.
2. Applicant must be enrolled in a minimum of 3 hours of core classes and a minimum of 6 total credit hours each semester.
3. Applicant must write a one page essay on "Why I feel I will be an excellent fitness professional."
4. Applicant must submit 3 letters of recommendation. Reference letters should be from: (1) a fitness professional, (2) a faculty/staff member from the Department of Behavioral Sciences, and (3) a former teacher, employer, etc. who can verify your suitability for pursuing a career in the health an fitness field.
