

THE JENNIE HAMILTON ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Jennie Hamilton was a 2003 graduate of Purdue University Calumet who devoted her all-too-brief life to health and fitness. At the time of her death in the summer of 2006, she was training for the Ironman Triathlon and considering returning to school in the Nursing program to further her ability to reach out to others and provide assistance for their health needs. This scholarship has been created by her family and her many friends to honor her memory and continue the legacy she began of health, fitness and education.

AWARD

One Purdue University Calumet student will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship for the academic year covering the fall semester of 2010 and the spring semester of 2011.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must have a 3.0 Grade Point Average.
2. Applicant must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 hours of undergraduate coursework for the fall semester of 2010.
3. Applicant must have attained sophomore status by the fall semester of 2010.
4. Applicant must be an HTM major with an option in Fitness Management or a Nursing major.
5. Applicant must write a one page essay on "Why I choose to pursue a career in a health field and how I plan to use my career to make a difference."
6. Applicant must submit 2 letters of recommendation. Reference letters should be from: 1) a faculty/staff member from the Department of Behavioral Sciences or Nursing (depending upon the major), and 2) a former teacher, employer, etc, who can verify your suitability for pursuing a career in the field of health or fitness.
